THERE IS NO TRIAL PERIOD WITH A UNION

If the Teamsters unionize you, the **union is permanent** unless team members decide to go through the long and difficult process called “decertification.”
It could take YEARS for team members to achieve this, if ever.

Here’s how the process works:



You have to wait at least **ONE YEAR** after an election before attempting to remove the Teamsters.



If a contract is reached, it could be up to **THREE YEARS** before you can attempt to remove the Teamsters.



If you miss the window for filing, it could be up to another **THREE YEARS** before you can try again.

You could be stuck with the union for a long time.
